What is it?

The XiA Community of Practice (CoP) is a pan-European, cross-sectoral ecosystem of changemakers committed to advancing innovation and interoperability in digital health.

It is a collective space where education, implementation and policy perspectives converge to:

- Strengthen advanced interoperability skills
- Support the adoption of Key Advanced Interoperability Standards (KAIS)
- Contribute to the implementation of the European Health Data Space (EHDS)
- Build a sustainable, future-proof digital health workforce

Develop and expand skills in advanced digital health interoperability standards across Europe.

Establish and maintain a vibrant ecosystem of stakeholders committed to collaboration, innovation and knowledge exchange.

Support long-term adoption of XiA educational outputs, micro-credentials and interoperability strategies across healthcare systems.

Through the Community of Practice, XiA aims to:

- ✓ Co-create and validate a European Interoperability Skills Strategy
- ✓ Support the design and uptake of KAIS micro-content, micro-courses and micro-credentials
- ✓ Bridge the skills gap in advanced interoperability standards (e.g., EHRxF, HL7 FHIR, SNOMED CT, IHE profiles)
- ✓ Facilitate knowledge exchange between healthcare professionals and IT professionals
- ✓ Contribute to policy recommendations at European, national and regional levels
- ✓ Foster cross-border collaboration and digital health transformation
- ✓ Build a strong alumni and change-agent network across Europe
- ✓ Ensure long-term sustainability of interoperability education

National standardisation organisations; designated bodies responsible for health IT or interoperability standards

Universities; public or private research institutes



Software vendors and IT solution providers

Electronic health record vendors; companies providing interoperability platforms or digital health solutions



IT developers and SMEs

Small software development companies; system integrators specialising in health IT

Patient advocacy groups; non-profit organisations working on health or digital rights

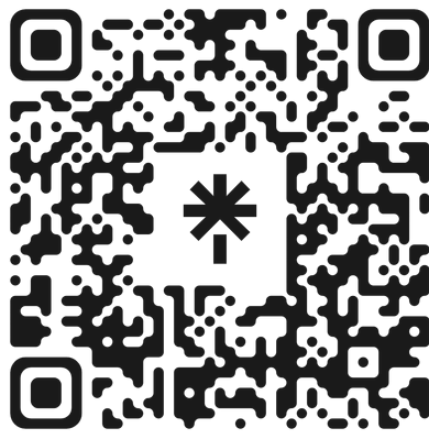
